BIO

Cuba 1967. Singer-songwriter and music producer. In 1994 founded and led the rock group **Lucha Almada**. At the end of the 80s and early 90s he grouped into the "Peña de 13 y 8" most of the later members of **Habana Oculta** (1995), then **Habana Abierta** since 1996 in Madrid, Spain.

In Vanito's songs a wide range of influences coexist and resonate with each other in a particularly organic fusion. "**Divino Guión**", "**Ahora Sí Tengo La Llave**", "**Lo Bueno No Sale Barato**", "**Corazón Boomerang**" or "**La Habana A Todo Color**" make up the phonographic repertoire of Habana Abierta.

In 2015 Vanito Brown made his solo debut with the album **NORTE SUR ESTE y AQUEL** (Bis Music 2014, accompanied by a valuable base of Cuban musicians (Gastón Joya, Yaroldi Abreu, Rodney Barreto and Tony Rodríguez) wich was singled out by **Billboards Latino** as one of the most influential Latin American pop that same year.
